We will then go to Roadford Lakeside for a finger buffet lunch and opportunity to have an easy walk around the lake to see its interesting sculptures as well as enjoy the wonderful views from the well equipped visitors centre. Timings have been changed a little in the light of the April visit.

13.15 Light buffet lunch in private room with tea and coffee

16.30 Return to Kingsbridge Quay via Modbury.
